

School Uniform (Year 9-11)

Regulation uniform items must be purchased from “Off the Cuff”, Stratford prior to the start of term. The PTA has a collection of second hand uniform for sale throughout the year. An order form is available with the school prospectus or from the main office.

How the uniform should be worn

- ✓ Uniform items are clean.
- ✓ Uniform is not ripped or drawn on.
- ✓ T-shirts or jewellery items are not visible.
- ✓ All clothing must be adequately named.

Shirt
SHS polo shirt in black only

Skirt
Black, red and white tartan skirt or culottes

Socks/Hose
White ankle length and/or black toned pantyhose

Polar fleece
SHS monogrammed black polar fleece

Shoes
Black, leather, lace-up shoes with low heels and no adornments of any kind or with a strap similar to the one pictured may be worn all year. Black sandals may be worn in Term 1 and 4 only (shoes/sandals are not available at “Off The Cuff”)

Formal wear

Plain white monogrammed blouse, with a red Stratford High School blazer

Regulation red monogrammed V-neck jersey

Shoes

Black, leather, lace-up shoes. Black sandals may be worn in Term 1 and 4 only (shoes/sandals are not available at "Off The Cuff")

A mixture of Year 9-11 (junior) and Year 12-13 (senior) uniform item is not permitted. Boys may wear either the formal or informal uniform (*a mixture is not permitted*)

Representing the school

The red school blazer is available for loan to pupils representing the school. This is worn with school uniform and school tie.

A school track suit or sports uniform is available to members of sports teams or students taking part in sports exchanges and TSSSA events. These are returned to the sports office after the event or at the end of the season.
