## Girls

### Shirt

*SHS polo shirt in black only*

### Skirt

*Black, red and white tartan skirt*

### Socks/Hose

*White ankle length socks or black toned pantyhose*

### Polar fleece

*SHS monogrammed black polar fleece*

### Shoes

*Black, leather, lace-up shoes. They may have a strap similar to the example. Black adornment free sandals may be worn in Term 1 and 4 only (shoes/sandals are available at "Scarpas").*

### School jacket

*Regulation black and red jacket (not worn in class)*

### Scarf

*Black or red or black/red mix (not worn in class)*

### PE uniform

*Y9-10 - Regulation PE T-shirt in the correct house colour (optional for Y11), black shorts.*

*Footwear: We strongly recommend students wear suitable sports shoes (not school shoes). All footwear worn in the stadium must have non-marking soles.*

### Sun hats / sunglasses

*Plain black sunhats or caps can be worn outside. Students may wear sunglasses outside during breaks if needed.*

# Stationery Requirements

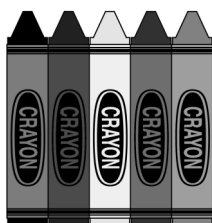
The following subjects will be studied in short modules throughout the year. Students will be notified of module requirements at the beginning of 2012.
